Select Today's Top News to view the latest market synopsis, top stories, economic calendar, and most read web stories.

Select the Calendars menu to view earnings, events, preannouncements, syndicate, economic, and conference calendars.

Select the Industry Data menu to view historical key metrics and consensus estimates for companies across 19 industries. The Drug Database provides comprehensive information on branded, generic, and pipeline drugs.

Click the Edit Start Page icon to select your favorite StreetAccount page and quickly access it from your toolbar.

Select the My Account menu to customize portfolios, sectors, email alerts, and site settings.

Use the Search field to search StreetAccount news by ticker, company name, or keyword.

Access additional options from the left pane, allowing you to filter your research, select date ranges, choose search options, and more depending on your view.

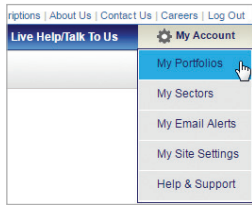

## Creating a Portfolio

1. Select "My Portfolios" from the My Account drop-down menu.



2. Click the **Create A New Portfolio** button to enter in your tickers or choose from StreetAccount's Country and Index Portfolios.
3. Type the tickers into the numbered fields or click the **Copy/Paste/Import** button to paste in tickers from a spreadsheet. Create up to 40 portfolios, with 500 tickers each.

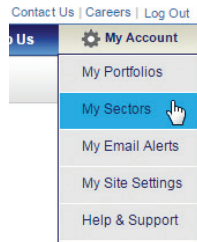
4. Click the "advanced options" link to change alert settings. Real-time alerts will be received by default; however, you can reduce the number of alerts by selecting a batched option.

5. Click the **Save** button to create your portfolio. After saving, you can easily view the coverage you can expect from StreetAccount for your tickers.

6. To view Portfolio Headlines within the site go to Real-Time News > Portfolio Headlines. You can filter on the portfolio you just created in the left pane.

## Creating a Custom Sector

1. Go to My Account > My Sectors



2. Click the **Create A New Custom Sector** button, and then name the sector.

3. Select the sector/industries you want to include. You can press the **CTRL** key or click and drag to select more than one at a time.

4. Use the >> to add the sector/industries into the Custom Sector section.

5. Make region selections and set market cap ranges.

6. (Optional) Select the "Email Alert" check box to receive alerts.

7. Click the "options" link next to the Email Alert check box to customize the alert settings. You can choose from real-time or batched alerts, select news categories, and set exclusions.

8. Click **Save** when finished.

9. To view Sector Headlines within the site, go to Real-Time News > Sector Headlines. You can filter on the sector you just created in the left pane.

## Viewing News Headlines

Select the Real-Time News drop-down menu and choose from the available menu options to target the news to your interests. Use the News Filters in the left pane to narrow your search to a number of default views, including Earnings, M&A, and Street Takeaways that summarize broker comments following major news events. You can also create custom filters that allow you to see only the news that's relevant to you.

Go to Real-Time News > Portfolio Headlines to filter on your portfolio(s).

Click **Launch Headlines** to get a smaller scrolling headline window that can be moved anywhere on your desktop.

Use the left pane to set default views, print a selected view, or access news archives.

After selecting Portfolio Headlines, you can highlight your portfolios and activate filters for scrolling news based on your coverage.

Select from the available news filters to narrow the focus of your headlines. Press and hold the **CTRL** key to select multiple filters. Once you've selected the desired filters, click the **Activate Filters** button to apply the filter(s) to your search.

### MARKET SYNOPSIS (last modified 16:08 ET on 14-Apr-21)

**US equities mixed: Dow +0.16%, S&P 500 (0.41%), Nasdaq (0.99%), Russell 2000 +0.84%**

- US equities mixed in Wednesday trading, ending near worst levels after spending the morning largely in positive territory. Growth trailed value, with tech, consumer discretionary, tech, and communication services the worst performers. FANMAG complex lower. Financials (banks), materials (industrial metals), industrials (machinery) among outperformers. Energy the leader on a strong day for crude. Treasuries unchanged to weaker at the long end after shaking off the hotter CPI readings in prior session with help from a strong bond auction. Dollar a bit weaker against the major currencies. Gold finished down 0.6%. WTI crude settled up 4.9% after big weekly US inventory draw and IEA demand boost.
- Value and cyclical outperformed growth and momentum today in a reversal of recent price action. Still a lot of moving pieces when it comes to rotation dynamics, including positioning, rates, vaccine progress and reopening momentum. Pretty quiet overall, fitting with recent depressed volume trend. Q1 earnings season still seen as next meaningful macro catalyst for stocks. However, while Street expects another quarter of outsized positive surprises, there is some debate about whether stocks will be able to take advantage of earnings beats given what has already been priced in.
- Earnings season in focus with some mixed but not surprising takeaways from the banking group. Fed Chair Powell reiterated policy is outcome based and would not put timeframe on liftoff. Vaccines also continue to get a lot of attention with doubts recent JNJ pause will dampen momentum, PFE helping to fill the gap and another good

**Growth/momentum an underperformer to value groups today:**

- Value groups recouped some recent underperformance to growth today. Reopening names are also broadly better following yesterday's selloff. Consumer discretionary worst performer with stocks mostly better but AMZN a big drag. Tech trailed with semis and software weakest (and MSFT, AAPL weighing). Communication services saw softness in internets (FB) and media (DISCA). Healthcare ahead with MedTech space largely lower but some cushion from managed care and biotech. Consumer staples an outperformer with grocers and tobacco among supports. Airlines mostly better in industrials, while machinery and multis helped as well. Industrial metals names (particularly aluminum/copper) boosted materials. Banks had a good day in financials as earnings season begins, though JPM's report had a few warts.
